We look forward to kicking off the **17th edition of the ACM Conference on Bioinformatics, Computational Biology, and Health Informatics – ACM BCB 2026** together.

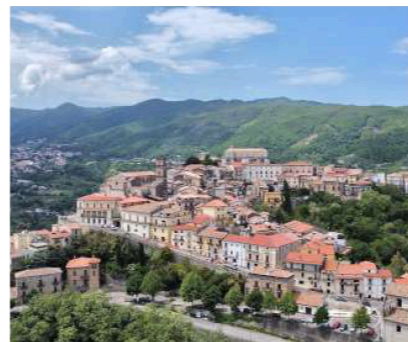

Tuesday, June 30 – Old Town Cosenza – Guided Tour of the Swabian Castle and Provincial Palace or City Tour on your own

The second social event features an evocative guided visit to two iconic landmarks in Cosenza, the **Swabian Castle (Castello Svevo)**, overlooking Pancrazio Hill, and the **Provincial Palace**, the institutional seat and home to significant artworks.

At 5:30 PM, a shuttle bus will depart from the University of Calabria conference center, arriving at **Piazza XV Marzo**.

Participants will be divided into two groups: one group will visit the Swabian Castle while the other will begin at the Provincial Palace. Halfway through, the groups will switch, allowing all participants to visit both sites with a dedicated guide.

The group will continue to the **Cathedral of Santa Maria Assunta**, designated a UNESCO “Heritage of a Culture of Peace” site, passing by the historic **Gran Caffè Renzelli**.

Descending toward the valley along the ancient **Corso Telesio**, the tour will reach the scenic viewpoint of the confluence of the Crati and Busento rivers, a legendary site of **Alaric’s treasure**.

The tour will conclude at **Piazza dei Bruzi**, the modern city square and location of Cosenza’s City Hall.

Dinner will be at the attendees' own expense. However, we are pleased to offer a few suggestions for those interested. Cosenza city center offers a wide variety of options, from traditional cuisine “**La Locanda**” and excellent pizzerias to more contemporary and creative spots, such as “**Il Moro Food and Vibes**” or **Cavò food & drink**. With such a rich selection, everyone is sure to find something to suit their tastes.

Return to the hotels is scheduled for 10:00 PM, with shuttle buses departing from **Piazza dei Bruzi**.

Wednesday, July 1 – Old Town Cosenza – Guided Tour of Palazzo Arnone and Social Dinner

Two evening activity options are available for participants on Thursday.

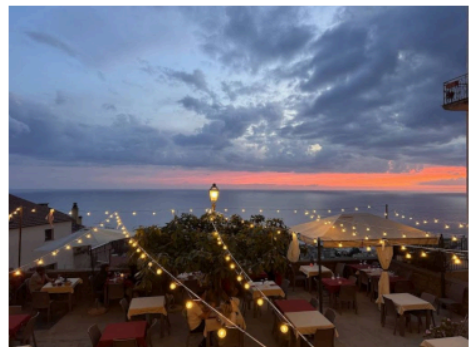
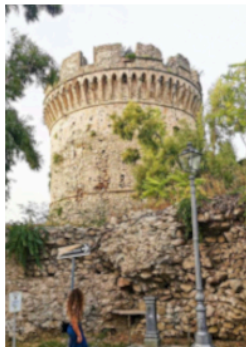
Option 1:

A pleasant guided visit to the town of **Belvedere Marittimo**, overlooking the Tyrrhenian Sea. Belvedere is about a 50-minute bus ride away, offering scenic views of the coast along the way.

Option 2:

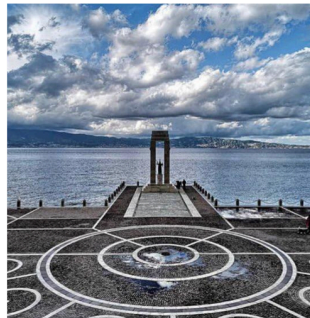
Participants may also choose to spend the evening independently, **on your own**, upon booking through **Viaggi di Cicci** or **Calabria Tour** or any tour operator of your choice

Some suggestions are:

- **Reggio Calabria** (~2h car ride from main Venue): enjoy a walk on the seafront, also known as “Il più bel chilometro d’Italia” (Italy’s most beautiful kilometer), and taste the famous ice cream from **Gelateria Cesare**. You may opt to visit the **National Archaeological Museum**, where the **Riace Bronzes** are displayed.
- **Tropea** (~1.5h car ride from main Venue): the “Pearl of the Tyrrhenian Sea” along the **Costa degli Dei**, in the province of Vibo Valentia. Just look up to be enchanted by the elegance of the old aristocratic palaces, the Baroque traces, the flower-covered balconies. End your *passaggiata* at the most photographed spot in the historic centre: the famous Largo Migliarese balcony overlooking the **Shrine of Santa Maria dell’Isola**.
- **Le Castella** (~2h car ride from main Venue): a renowned seaside destination along the **Costa dei Saraceni**, at the center of the **"Isola Capo Rizzuto" Marine Protected Area**, the wildest and historically richest coastal areas of the Calabrian Middle Ionian Sea.
